

## INFORMATION FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA - SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

*EU General Regulation on the protection of personal data n. 679/2016 GDPR*

With this Privacy Policy ("Disclosure") AIMO Srl, as the data controller (hereinafter "Owner" or "AIMO") illustrates, pursuant to EU Regulation 679/2016 ("GDPR") and the applicable legislation, including national, on the subject of personal data protection, the methods in which and the purposes for which the data collected with reference will be processed.

### **Holder of the treatment**

The Data Controller, pursuant to European Regulation 2016/679, provides you with the following information:

### **1. Purpose of the treatment**

The object of the processing by the Data Controller is the personal data communicated by you on the occasion of your participation in the realization of the Research Project entitled A double armed randomized control trial evaluating the effects of OMT on pain perception in patients with plantar fasciitis.\_\_\_\_\_.

On the occasion of these treatments, the Data Controller may become aware of particular categories of personal data, always processed for scientific research purposes pursuant to art. 9, par. 2, of the GDPR.

Your personal data are processed by the Data Controller for the following purposes:

a) Participation in the implementation of the Research Project entitled A double armed randomized control trial evaluating the effects of OMT on pain perception in patients with plantar fasciitis.\_\_\_\_\_ (pursuant to art. 9 of the GDPR)

b) Storage and use for further scientific research and publications of subsequent / future studies or use your clinical data in projects and / or activities for didactic, training, information purposes, always guaranteeing pseudonymisation (pursuant to art.9 of the GDPR )

c) detect your degree of satisfaction with the quality of services, for the purpose of analyzing the service offered with the aim of continually improving the service, treating them anonymously.

We remind you that the granting of the consent of the two points above is not mandatory (free choice is left); failure to consent, however, makes it impossible to participate in the Scientific Research Project.

d) marketing purposes: sending by e-mail, post and / or telephone contacts of newsletters, and / or information material, commercial communications and / or advertising material on products or services offered by the Data Controller.

### **2. Processing methods and storage duration**

The personal data collected will form the subject of processing operations in compliance with the aforementioned legislation and the confidentiality obligations which inspire the activity of the Data Controller. The data will be processed both with IT tools and on paper supports and on any other type of suitable support (eg cloud systems, archiving systems and digital replacement storage, ...), in compliance with adequate technical and organizational security measures provided for by GDPR.

### **3. Access to data**

Your data may be made accessible for the aforementioned purposes:

- exclusively by authorized personnel in charge of processing or by the Data Processor designated by the Data Controller.
- The research results may be disseminated exclusively in aggregate and completely anonymous form;
- your personal data will not be disclosed.

### **4. Communication of data**

The disclosure of statistical and / or scientific results (for example through the publication of scientific articles and / or the creation of databases, also with open access methods, participation in conferences, etc.) may only take place in anonymous and / or aggregate form. and in any case in ways that do not make you identifiable.

#### **5. Data transfer**

Personal data may be transferred to those third countries (eg the United Kingdom) which guarantee an adequate level of protection substantially equivalent to that ensured within the Union, on the basis of an adequacy decision of the European Commission. This transfer takes place to allow the pursuit of the educational purposes provided for the provision of those courses, organized by AIMO and validated by an external academic body.

#### **6. Rights of the interested party**

The interested party always has the right to request from the Data Controller access to your Data, the correction or cancellation of the same, the limitation of processing or the possibility of opposing the processing, to request the portability of the Data, to revoke the consent to the processing (in this case it is understood that the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal) by asserting these and the other rights provided for by the GDPR by simply communicating to the Data Controller. The interested party can also lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority (in Italy it is the Privacy Guarantor).

#### **7. Procedures for exercising rights**

You can exercise your rights at any time by sending:
